KENNEDY HIGH the global school has successfully accomplished **16 years** of excellence in the field of education by focusing on child-centric education.

During this journey, we received **Best school in India** award in the **Rio United Nations Contest** and **National School Sanitation award** for attaining 94% in Green category by CBSE. The **Swami Vivekananda Award** is a proof of our philosophy of value-based education.

To raise awareness about COVID-19 during this pandemic, we created PPTs and organized webinars for the students, parents and staff.

Our aim was to make the teaching learning process as secure and effective as possible. We restricted the number of students and to deliver quality content online, we incorporated blended learning with flipped classes.

Apart from curriculum, students' socio- emotional well-being, along with cultivating critical, creative, flexible thinking, resilience, and empathy, is also being taken care of. Our teachers participated in capacity building workshops to keep abreast of the current scenario and continue to upgrade their teaching learning process.

Owing to our combined efforts, teaching learning approach has become interdisciplinary, experiential, joyful, Art- integrated and project- based, where in students are encouraged to apply their knowledge to solve real-world problems.

We have been conducting online assessments regularly and our students are scaling new heights academically.

Key features of our school

Safety of children in and outside the school premises is our top priority. CCTV Cameras are available throughout the school premises including playgrounds, Secondary and Senior secondary classrooms as well as in all school buses which can be viewed live from the school control room.

Our classrooms are **digitally equipped** with SMART boards that enhance students' learning experience.

The **three essential pillars** of our school are the Pre-Primary Wing, CBSE Wing, and the Cambridge Wing, which are supported by a team of around 200 committed, qualified and well-trained teachers and dedicated non-teaching staff. Above all, parents, are the strongest pillars of this institution.

Health and Physical Education has been given a prominent place in the school curriculum along with academics. We have a team of well-trained physical education teachers who coach the students in Volleyball, basketball, football, skating, athletics, swimming, taekwondo, yoga, cricket, tennis, handball, chess and table tennis.

To equip the Principal and the mentors with the changes taking place in education, they have been given an opportunity to attend motivational workshops, exchange programmes & training sessions at regular intervals in our school and schools in other cities.
